Action item

Learner profile

Chris Hall from Davis school district took a few minutes to discuss a new project that the district is currently working on. The projects will look at creating new dispositions at school. This would be changed from the current DESK model. What makes a creator, how to generate novel ideas in kids, what skills can we help develop in the school are all topics discussed and as teachers and parents we were able to give brainstorming ideas. Experiences are a great way to provide guidance without judgement. Self-reflection was also discussed as a way of monitoring this new wellness project.
