

## **ST. ANTHONY-NEW BRIGHTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS SUMMARY OF HEALTH & SAFETY PROGRAMS - JANUARY 2021**

St. Anthony-New Brighton Public Schools complies with all applicable requirements documented in Health and Safety Policy 807. This document summarizes current district health and safety plans, inspections, programs, and other essential activities required to comply with all federal, state, and local health and safety regulations.

This document will serve as an addendum to Health and Safety Policy 807 for review by the School Board.

### **District Health & Safety Plans**

All management plans, inspection reports, testing results, training records, etc. are available electronically for review by request. The district has the following management plans in place that are reviewed annually and updated as needed:

**AED** – Includes inventory, inspections, maintenance and updates

**Aerial Lift** – Includes inventory and tri-annual training for operators

**Asbestos** – Includes AHERA required semi-annual inspections, awareness training, operations and maintenance, and abatement designs and removal reports

**Bleacher Safety** – Includes inspection and certification every 5 years

**Bloodborne Pathogens** – Includes annual training for all staff

**Chemical Hygiene** – Includes annual training, chemical inventory, and annual inspections for laboratory safety and fume hood performance

**Community Right to Know** – Includes annual Tier II reporting

**Compressed Gas** – Includes inventory, annual inspections, and training

**Confined Space** – Includes inventory and classifications of confined spaces, and annual training

**Employee Right to Know** – Includes chemical safety, safety data sheets (SDS) for chemicals used, safe work practices, annual inspections of emergency eyewash/shower units and annual training. SDSs for chemicals used in the district are maintained online through MSDSONline.

**Fall Protection** – Includes fall hazard assessments and annual training

**Fire Safety** – Includes fire safety site plans and emergency evacuation and shelter plans

**Hazardous Waste** – Includes proper storage and disposal of hazardous wastes and annual licensing as a very small quantity generator through Hennepin County

**Hearing Conservation** – Includes noise monitoring, hearing protection, and annual training and audiograms for staff currently on the hearing conservation program

**Industrial Arts Safety** – Includes machine guarding, safe work practices and annual training

**Integrated Pest Management** – Includes types and frequency of pesticide use at the facility and annual and requested notifications of application

**Ladder Safety** – Includes inventory, safe work practices, and annual training

**Lead in Water** – Includes testing schedule and results of testing

**Lockout-Tagout** – Includes specific procedures for lockout-tagout, safe work practices, annual training and periodic inspections

**Indoor Air Quality (IAQ)** – Includes annual IAQ walkthrough inspection and air quality testing, annual IAQ survey for staff, and investigations and applicable testing for areas of concern

**Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)** – Includes PPE assessments and types of PPE available

**Playground Safety** – Includes playground inspections and maintenance

**Radon** – Includes testing schedule and results of testing

**Respiratory Protection** – Includes respirator requirements, annual fit testing and training

**Safety Committee** – Includes agenda and minutes for quarterly meetings

**Underground Storage Tank (UST)** – Includes inventory and management
