

Dental Coverage

Children

Children who have health coverage through **Medi-Cal** or a **Covered California** health plan also have dental coverage.

Dental services include:

- Exams
- Cleanings
- X-rays
- Fillings
- Relief of pain and infection
- Medically necessary orthodontics
- Sealants
- Fluoride treatments
- Tooth extractions
- Root canals
- Emergency services

Children should visit a dentist as soon as their first tooth appears or by age 1.

Adults

Adults who have health coverage through **Medi-Cal** also have dental coverage.

Dental services include:

- Exams
- Cleanings
- X-rays
- Crowns
- Other medically necessary dental services
- Fluoride treatments
- Fillings
- Dentures
- Root canals

Dental services may exceed the annual \$1,800 limit if shown to be medically necessary.

Adults who have a **Covered California** health plan may also be eligible for many dental benefits.

Finding a Dentist

Medi-Cal

The Medi-Cal Benefits Identification Card is also the card used for dental coverage called Denti-Cal.
