What to Expect

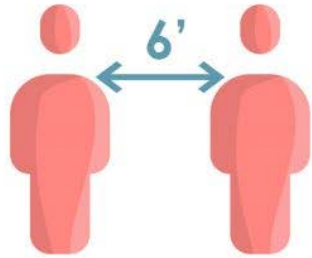
- Parents/Guardians please conduct a self screener with your child/children before sending them to school
- You may also submit a daily student self screening using School Self Screening App. [COVID-19 Schools Self Screening Instructions](#) - English
- Students may come to campus no earlier than 7:30 am, school begins at 8:05 am 6th-8th, 8:15 am K-5
- One entrances by the Cafeteria
- One entrance by the bus zone near the JSJCS office
- Students must come to school with a mask
- Students will go to designated outdoor tables
- Temperature checks will be done before entering campus

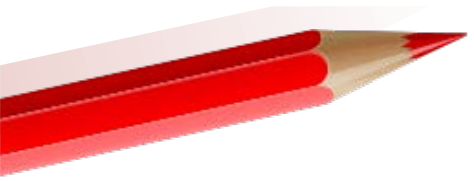
Everyone must wear a mask

No shared supplies

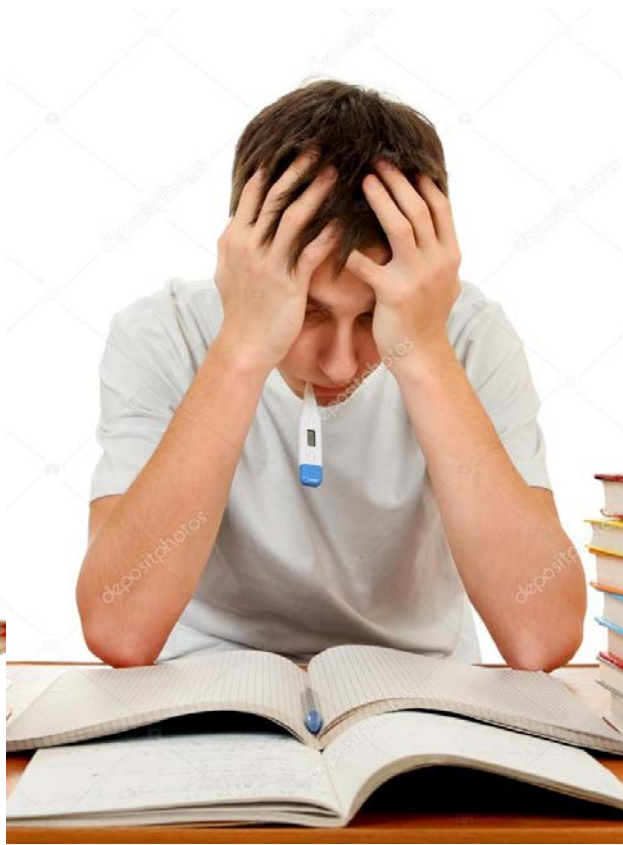


Isolating & sending home those who are symptomatic

Safety Protocols

- Classes will not interact with other classes during instructional time
- Recesses will be staggered
- Furniture in classrooms will be arranged to maximize space
- Students will line up and walk with space between each student
- Distancing protocols in classrooms will be 3ft and reflect public health guidance
- The number of visitors to the office at one time will be limited to accommodate distancing
- PPE is available to all staff and students as needed
- Staff will conduct a self screener before coming on campus
- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms may not enter campus

Sick Students on Campus



- Students with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will go to the office
- The library is the designated isolation room M, T, W and Friday, the counselor's room Th to separate any students not feeling well from others
- Office or support staff will contact parents to pick up the child

Exposure/Positive Case Protocols

- The district follows the CalOSHA and CDPH guidelines and protocols for any individual who has been exposed or is a positive case. Employees and students should follow the Pandemic plan:


Recess- Purple/Red Tier


