
New legislation requires -

Integration of both physical and mental health in the health curriculum and expand e-cigarette awareness. (HB 18)

Strategies and policies to increase parental awareness regarding risky behaviors and **early warning signs of suicide risks and behavioral health concerns**, including mental health disorders and substance use disorders, as well as **available community programs** and **services** to address these concerns. (SB 11)

SHAC to develop and issue statements on –

- The policies and procedures adopted to promote the physical health and mental health of students
- The physical health and mental health resources available at each campus, contact information for the nearest providers of essential public health services
- Contact information for the nearest local mental health authority. (HB 18)
