

Community Parking During STEAM Construction

Parking from Term 2, 2021

Due to construction of the BGS STEAM Precinct, the car park at the rear of the School (College Rd entrance) will be closed from the start of Term 2. Oval No. 2 will be converted into comparably sized parking for the duration of construction, but will **only be accessible to the community after school hours (3.45pm weekdays and on weekends)**.



No morning parking – drop-off only

All parking areas, including at the BGS Tennis Centre, will require a BGS staff card to access. Students arriving for morning training can be dropped off in the School's drop-off/pick-up zone, accessed at the intersection of Gregory Terrace and Boundary Street. Afternoon and event parking

The boom gates at Oval No. 2 and the BGS Tennis Centre will be open for the community from **3.45pm on weekdays and on weekends for sport or community events**. Please see the map on the following page.



Wet weather considerations

Kalinga Avenue is narrow and has a steep gradient. Care is required when driving in wet conditions.



Night safety — security and lighting

• Security lighting will be installed for the temporary car park on Oval No. 2.



Traffic guidance

- There will be traffic control workers at the top and bottom ends of Kalinga Avenue during peak times to assist traffic flow.
- Please be aware of peak traffic congestion periods as this may assist when planning your journeys to and from BGS this includes drop-off (7.45am 8.15am) and pick-up (3.15pm 3.45pm).
- The gate at the back of the BGS drop-off/pick-up zone that parents sometimes use to exit via Kalinga Avenue will be closed during peak times to minimise congestion.
- No right-hand turn into Gregory Terrace when exiting from Kalinga Avenue.
- No right-hand turn into Kalinga Avenue when entering from Gregory Terrace.
