### **AHERA Annual Asbestos Notification**

During the past school year and continuing into the 2019-2020 school year the following asbestos management plan activities have been or are currently being completed. These activities are pursuant to the Environmental Protection Agency 40 CFR Part 763-“Asbestos Containing Materials in Schools; Final Rule and Notice.”

- One Periodic Surveillance Inspection
- One 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Reinspection
- Notification of Asbestos Locations for Short-Term Workers (Electricians, Plumbers, etc.)
- Training of District Personnel

Over the summer, two small asbestos abatement jobs were completed at Jefferson Elementary. The district used licensed abatement firms under the direction from a 3<sup>rd</sup> party air monitoring/project design firm. For the 2019-2020 school year, Faribault Public Schools does not have any major response actions planned.

Faribault Public Schools has contracted through the Southeast Service Cooperative with the Institute for Environmental Assessment to provide environmental consulting services.

The complete updated Asbestos Management Plan for Faribault Public Schools can be found in the Buildings and Grounds Office or in the administrative office at each of the school facilities.
