

## **Bear Creek High School Dress Code Policies**

1. All clothes must be neat, clean, not frayed or cut off, in good repair, and an appropriate size.
2. No bare midriffs, backs or chests (boys or girls). All tops must have at least a 1 inch strap and no part of any undergarment may show.
3. Shorts and skirts must be at a minimum of fingertip length and pants and shorts must be worn at the waist.
4. Male tank-top undershirts will not be permitted.
5. No oversized or sagging pants or undergarments showing.
6. No headbands, hair nets, bandannas, belt buckles with punched out letters, cutoffs, or pajamas.
7. Hats/hoods and/or sunglasses are not to be worn indoors.
8. Shoes must be worn at all times. No spike heels, house slippers or “wheely’s” are allowed.
9. Clothing, and/or accessories that *advertise or allude to violence, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, controlled substances, contain sexual innuendo or are sexually explicit* are prohibited on school grounds and at school activities on and off campus.
10. The policy further prohibits the presence of *any apparel (including hats) jewelry, accessories, notebooks, or manner of grooming (including haircuts) which, by virtue of its color, arrangement, trademark or any other attribute, denotes membership in a gang or group.*
11. Only BCHS baseball or black or white woolen caps (during cold weather) are currently permitted to be worn or carried on campus.

**Student attire that is deemed inappropriate is at the discretion of the administration.**
