	<p>White shirt with tie or white blouse (may be short-sleeved in hot weather) (PJ)</p>		<p>Ties: (Years 7 & 8, silver/black), (Years 9-11 House colours – listed overleaf) (PJ)</p>
			<p>Shoes: Plain black, formal style, polished leather (not boots, suede, canvas or ballet pumps). Heel no higher than 4cm.</p>
<p>Plain dark socks with trousers or black 40 denier or above tights or white ankle socks (not trainer socks) with skirts.</p>			
	<p>Summer polo: unfitted white/black with School crest or fitted black/white with School crest (S)</p>		<p>Football shorts or skirt: black/white with School crest (S)</p>
	<p>Either tracksuit bottoms: black with School crest or fitted training pants with School crest (S)</p>		<p>Either tracksuit top or mid-layer: black with School crest (S)</p>

Swimming trunks/jammers/shorts/one-piece costume: plain black Swimming cap: (for long hair) any colour Shin pads: suitable for hockey or football Hockey/Football socks: plain, long black PE socks: short white Sports trainers: (with non-marking soles) Football boots: (suitable for football on grass) House shirt: (Year 9 and above) short-sleeved in House colours (listed overleaf) (S)

Cricket trousers (compulsory for team players)	White
Cricket shirt (compulsory for team players)	White, with School crest (S)
Cricket sweater (compulsory for team players)	White, with School crest (with or without sleeves) (S)
Baselayers	Plain black (S)
Cricket boots/shoes (team members only)	White, for outdoor wear
School bags: Any colour/shape/design. A medium-sized bag/rucksack with capacity of 40 litres should suffice for daily use. A slightly larger, additional bag is needed for sports kit and 50-60 litre capacity should be sufficient.
