A RESOLUTION requesting a waiver from the state high school graduation requirements for Maritime High School in Highline Public Schools.

WHEREAS, Highline Public Schools is a duly organized political subdivision of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, WAC 180-51-060 through 068 outlines the minimum subject areas for high school graduation credits based on when a student starts high school; and

WHEREAS, WAC 180-18-055 outlines a process for alternative high school graduation requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Highline School District Board of Directors has established a vision for college and career preparation for all high school students in the context of rigorous standards; and

WHEREAS, the district has a bold goal of every student graduating prepared for the future they choose; and

WHEREAS, that bold goal will be best met by allowing schools like Maritime High School the freedom to innovate while being held accountable to high standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Highline School District No. 401, King County, Washington, approves the application by Maritime High School to the State Board of Education requesting a waiver from the requirements of WAC 180-51-061 (1)(a) through (h) and 180-51-068 (1) through (9).
