QUALIFICATIONS:

The employee has a 40-hour workweek with occasional required overtime and must be able to respond to emergencies on a 24-hour basis. Must be able to lift 50 pounds. A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with school bus and air brake endorsement is required for the position. Maintenance Assistants shall hold a valid state driver's license and within six months of employment or secure a CDL and proper certification to operate a school bus with air brakes within 120 days of hire. Thereafter, certification shall be maintained to operate a school bus. The employee shall have a high school diploma or general education degree (GED) plus vocational training or two years of experience and/or training; or equivalent combination and experience. Employees are expected to be proficient in their responsibilities and provide leadership to others.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Be familiar with and utilize maintenance manuals provided by equipment suppliers relative to proper settings, maintenance, and operation of all equipment in the School Corporation. This includes such equipment as:
 - a. Boiler and burner operation
 - b. Air-conditioning equipment
 - c. Wall heating units
 - d. Circulation of air and water throughout the building
- 2. Diagnose electrical and mechanical problems, then make necessary repairs as needed.
- 3. Diagnose plumbing problems and make repairs as needed.
- 4. The Maintenance Assistant shall complete work orders as approved by the supervisor.
- 5. On a routine basis, check all trucks, tractors, and spare buses for repair and service. Add fluids if necessary.
- 6. Observe all laws and standards as set forth under IOSHA and AHERA.
- 7. Recommend the need for supplies and/or equipment to the supervisor.
- 8. The Maintenance Assistant shall clean instructional areas as assigned.

- 9. Remove snow/ice from playgrounds, parking areas, and sidewalks prior to the arrival of parents, staff, students, and buses.
- 10. The Maintenance Assistant shall maintain the security of all equipment and buildings.
- 11. The Maintenance Assistant shall maintain continual education in this job.
- 12. The Maintenance Assistant shall maintain a positive relationship with other staff, parents, and students.
- 13. The Maintenance Assistant shall maintain fields for practice and competition as necessary.
- 14. The Maintenance Assistant shall care for lawn and grounds as needed by mowing, trimming, etc.
- 15. Transport students and assist with transportation needs as assigned by the Superintendent or the Director of Buildings and Grounds.
- 16. The Maintenance Assistant shall perform other duties, as assigned by the Superintendent, the Director of Buildings and Grounds, or out of necessity to fulfill the requirements of the position.
