## Front Lobby Renovation

The renovated front lobby of Buffalo Creek Elementary now boasts a welcoming new reception area, complete with colorful graphics and upgraded furniture.

## Classroom Renovations

Through the renovation project, each classroom was affected where new technology/active walls were added for teaching, along with new carpet, paint and lighting. In addition, all restrooms and wash areas were renovated to help make the spaces more efficient and useable.

## Library Renovation

The library was upgraded with new a ceiling and lighting, and a skylight and a new perimeter window wall system, helping with improving acoustics and bringing light and openness to the space.

New furniture, bookshelves and a new active wall for additional learning area complete the space. The library renovation supports the district and school's focus on literacy by providing a place to collaborate, research, and immerse students in the joy of reading.

## New Collaboration Areas
