LEGAL NOTICE TOWN OF VERNON VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING AND SPECIAL TOWN MEETING FEBRUARY 16, 2021

This is to give Notice that on February 2, 2021, in accordance with Chapter XII Section 10(f) of the Vernon Town Charter, the Vernon Town Council scheduled a Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting to be held February 16, 2021. The Public Hearing portion will be conducted via teleconference call. Please see login information below. The Special Meeting vote will be conducted via secure drive-through or walk-up outside and in front of the Town Hall Memorial Building, 14 Park Place, Vernon, Connecticut. This meeting is to hear comments and take the necessary action relative to the following Resolution recommended by the Mayor:

HEAR COMMENTS AND TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTION REGARDING THE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF **\$471,450.00** TO FUND THE CENTER ROAD SCHOOL ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT, SAID FUNDS TO COME FROM THE GENERAL FUND BALANCE AND TRANSFER TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS BUDGET.

WHEREAS, with reference to the Vernon Town Charter, Chapter XII, Section 10(f), additional appropriations in excess of 1/10 of 1% of the total budget require a public hearing and approval at a special town meeting. The total budget for the relevant fiscal year is \$94,100,096.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved: That the Town Council hereby approves an additional appropriation in an amount of \$471,450.00 to the fiscal year 2020-2021 capital improvement budget, account 10780290 - 57292, for funding the Center Road School roof replacement project.

Said Virtual Public Hearing will take place at 7:45 p.m. to be held via a telephone conference call. Interested parties must call 1-929-205-6099; Meeting ID# 811 1990 4809; Password: 0216. Said Special Town Meeting will take place at 7:55 p.m. in front of Town Hall, 14 Park Place, wherein qualified electors and qualified property owners will drive up, remain in their vehicle to vote in a secure drive-through manner. Accommodations for walk-up voting will be made as well. Voting shall conclude at 9:15 p.m. All parties must present a current photo ID then vote in the affirmative or negative by show of hand.
