ICYMI: 1/13/21 Parent Communication: Details for Phase 3 starting 1/19/21

Centaurus Students and Families-

We are excited to welcome students back to in-person learning starting on January 19th. We have updated the Centaurus High Return to School Guidelines Q3 document to reflect current information, and I would like everyone to read through this so that you know what to expect next week. I would also like to take this opportunity to highlight some important changes that we have made to ensure student and staff safety with the increased numbers of students in the building.

- **Bell Schedule:** We have changed our bell schedule starting on January 19th, specifically moving our lunch period to be after third period. We are doing this to allow students who do not have a fourth period the option of leaving, which will reduce overall numbers in our common areas during lunch.
 - Please know that both breakfast and lunch for all students is free until the end of the school year.
 - Breakfast will be available before school. In addition, as lunch is later, we will also have "grab and go" breakfast available for students between 1st and 2nd period if they did not have a chance to grab breakfast earlier.
- Open Campus: We will be reverting back to an open campus this quarter, meaning that students may leave during open periods and/or lunch and then come back to the building. We will have to re-check that students' COVID screeners were completed when they return. We encourage all students to follow health and safety guidelines including wearing masks and social distancing when they are out in the community.
- Cohorts: During phase 3 hybrid learning which begins January 19th, high school students will attend in person classes at Centaurus two days per week.
 - Students who had been attending in person on either Tuesday or Wednesday (in November) will attend on both Tuesday and Wednesday now. Students who had been
 attending in person on either Thursday or Friday will attend on both Thursday and Friday now.
 - Infinite Campus will reflect student cohorts beginning January 18. Here are instructions for how to locate this information.

Again, we look forward to seeing your students in person again starting on the 19th. Please make sure to review the Centaurus High Return to School Guidelines Q3 document with your student prior to next week.

Advisory Update

This week during Advisory, students received remote learning tips to help kick off Quarter 3. They also received individualized support and mentoring.

Next week, January 20, Advisory lessons will differ by grade level:

Freshmen - Students will complete a Naviance lesson to be determined.

<u>Sophomores</u> - In Naviance, students complete an interactive slideshow where they read about unique qualities and make a list of some that they possess. Students then make a plan to develop one of their own unique qualities.

Juniors - In Naviance, students will be taking a college interest survey in order to narrow down college choices.

<u>Seniors</u> - Advisory classes will be discussing professional email etiquette for both college and the workplace, as well as going over some advice for interacting with professors in college.


