Events include:

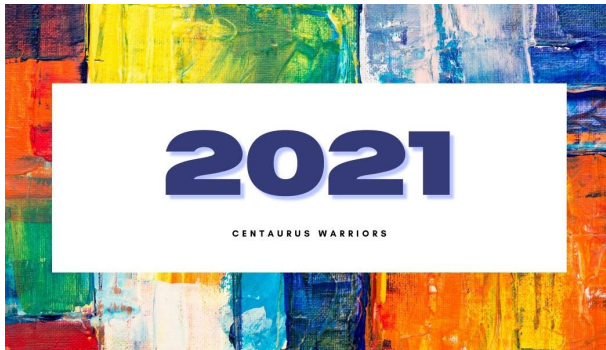
- Restaurant Wars! Competition to see what class can raise the most money by eating at Chipotle Monday 22nd or MOD Pizza Wednesday 24th.

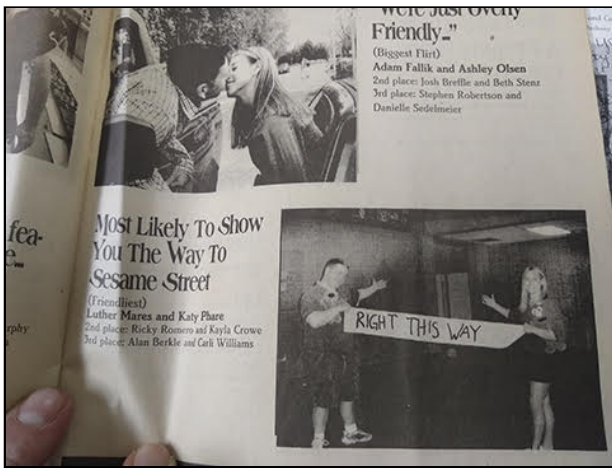
