New From the Principal

Centaurus Students and Families-

As was announced at the BVSD Board of Education meeting on Tuesday, Centaurus High School will be working to provide additional support for students on Mondays. Starting on Monday, February 1st, Centaurus will be open from 12:00-3:30 to students. This will be optional for students, but will provide a safe place for students to complete academic work as well as access mental health support as needed. We will have common areas open to students and will provide supervision during this time. As the semester progresses, we hope to add additional support (both academic and social/emotional) during this time and will communicate this information as we have it.

For now, please note the following:

- Starting on Monday, February 1st, Centaurus will be open from 12:00-3:30 to students.
- Students will be supervised and provided space to work in our common areas.
- Student will need to complete the **Daily Health Check Form** and sign in upon arrival
- Students will need to follow all school guidelines around
- Mental Health Support will be available by appointment during this time, as it is throughout the week. Please fill out this **appointment request form** to schedule with a member of our counseling department.
 - In addition, during this time on Monday we will also have members of our counseling department on site for drop in mental health support.
- This is optional for students, but we do hope that students who could benefit from additional structure and support on Mondays will take advantage of this opportunity.
