

Minutes of the Community Council Meeting

April 7, 2021

Item 1 Those in attendance were welcomed: Doug Hammerschmidt, Lori James, Andrea Jenkins, Andrea Davis, Lindsay Blackburn Anna Jeffrey, and Robyn Gabriel

Item 2 Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Item 3 Principal Hammerschmidt led the discussion on the proposed 2021-2022 School Improvement Plan and the changes that had been made from the last meeting. The goals were clarified, the means to measure the growth was specified, and changes were made and finalized.

The Proposed 2021-2022 School Improvement Plan was approved by a 7 to 7 vote by the those in attendance.

Item 4 Principal Hammerschmidt reported on the Trust lands Funding.

Mr. Hammerschmidt reported on how the current year's funds are being spent, any surplus and how that surplus is being used to save money by paying some expenditures in advance (at a discounted rate) for the following year.

He listed the proposed 2021-2022 expenditures, indicating that the projected funds will be received will be less money than for this current year.

The Committee approved the 2021-2022 budget by a 7 to 7 vote by the those in attendance.

Item 5 The Principal listed some Community Items that were discussed.

End of Level Testing will be starting soon with the Testing Window going from April 5-May 14 for K-6.

The school musical, "Lion King, Jr." will be performed starting the end of April. There will be a need to block off the parking lot to reserve parking for attendees of the play, instead of community field events during that same time period.
