These last few days are a reminder that Spring has arrived and that summer cannot be too far off on the horizon, providing a much-needed respite for all. With the start of the fourth marking period, the district will be returning to in-person instruction on April 19, 2021, for all students who selected that option. Please, know that our administrative team and support staff worked diligently during this time of remote learning to prepare our schools for students and staff to safely return. I, along with our central administrative team, have visited our buildings and classrooms and have been extremely pleased with the preparation of our facilities. In almost all cases, we are exceeding the CDC guidelines for social distancing in schools, and are able to place students six feet apart in their classrooms. Additionally, added lunch spaces have been provided for staff and students to safely eat during the school day while still maintaining the recommended social distancing.
