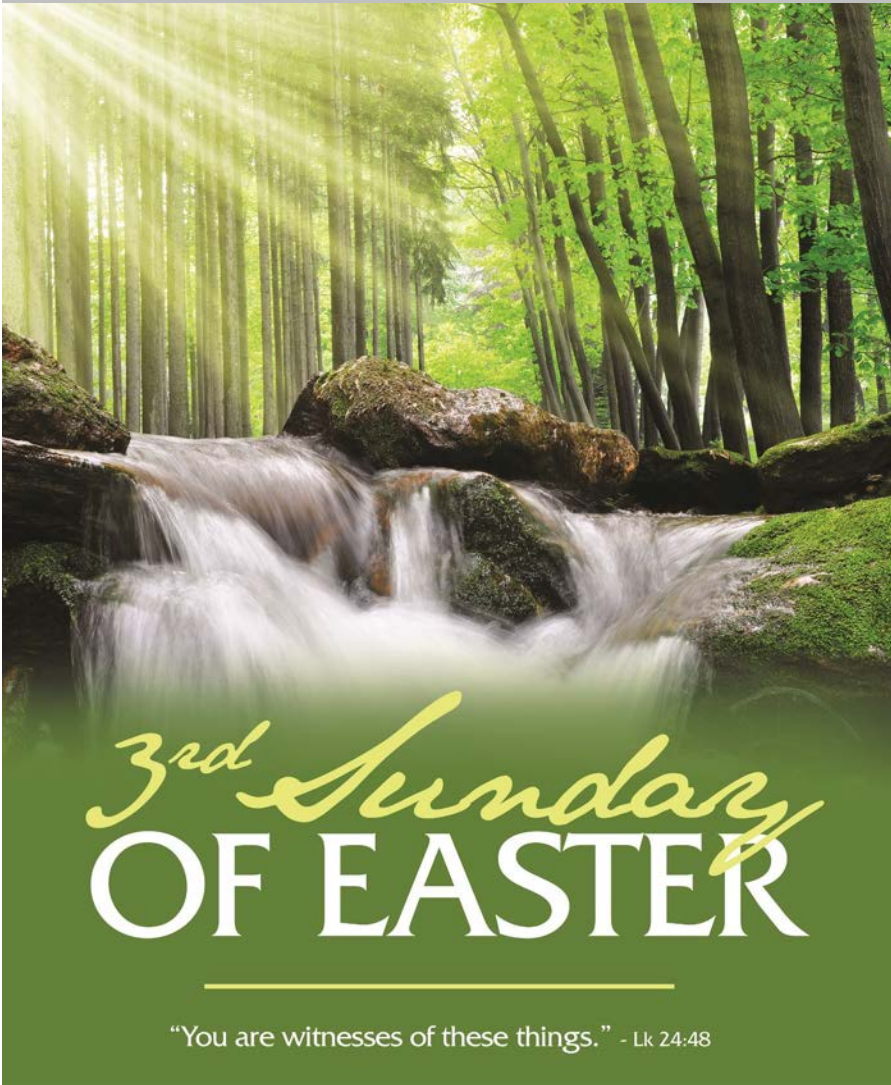

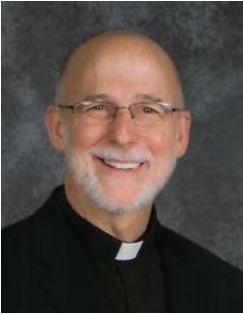


Rectory Office Remains Closed to Visitors

Trust and Mercy. Everything Jesus revealed to St. Faustina can be summed up in these two words. Jesus' message to the polish nun St. Maria Faustina Kowalska and through her to the world was one of his infinite mercy, his

desire to forgive the worst of sinners, and reconcile all to himself. He calls us to trust in the ocean of his mercy, and then to mediate that mercy to others.

Last week we celebrated Divine Mercy Sunday, a feast Jesus asked Sr. Faustina to promote. It was Pope John Paul II who established this feast in the year 2000 on the second Sunday of Easter when he also canonized St. Faustina. The Pope was deeply devoted to Divine Mercy, having written an encyclical on it in 1980. He saw the preaching of Divine Mercy as a central mission of his papacy, once saying: "Right from the beginning of my ministry in St. Peter's See in Rome, I consider this message [of Divine Mercy] my special task. Providence has assigned it to me in the present situation of man, the Church and the world. It could be said that precisely this situation assigned that message to me as my task before God." The saintly pope was convinced that the message of Divine Mercy was the most powerful way to proclaim the Gospel in today's world. In his 2001 homily on Divine Mercy Sunday, John Paul II pointed to the revelations of Faustina as "the appropriate and incisive answer that God wanted to offer to the questions and expectations of human beings in our time, marked by terrible tragedies... Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift that the church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity at the dawn of the third millennium." The Pope trusted in Divine Mercy to the end, dying in 2005 on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday.

"All grace flows from mercy . . . Let no one doubt concerning the goodness of God; even if a person's sins were as dark as night, God's mercy is stronger than our misery. One thing alone is necessary; that the sinner set ajar the door of his heart, be it ever so little, to let in a ray of God's merciful grace, and then God will do the rest" (St. Faustina, Diary No. 1507). Let us place all our trust in Jesus' Divine Mercy, and let our lives in turn become living witnesses of that mercy to others.

Jesus, I trust in you! St. Faustina, Pray for us.

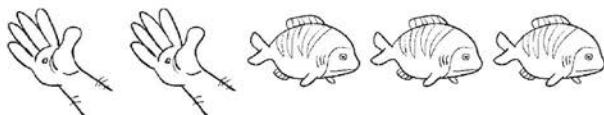

Praying with the Mass Readings

Spiritual reading of Sacred Scripture is a form of prayer called **lectio divina**.

1. Begin... *Come, Holy Spirit*
2. Read (lectio): Read the Mass Bible passage. Read it carefully, two or three times. Let it really soak in. Underline a word or sentence that stands out to you.
3. Meditation (meditatio). Ponder the words of the passage that stood out to you. Allow yourself to be moved by the Word of God to discover its meaning for your life.
4. Prayer (oratio). Speak to God about the passage. Be yourself. Allow time for silence to let God speak back to you. In this prayerful engagement with the Bible passage, you open yourself up to the possibility of contemplation.
5. Contemplation (contemplatio): Resting in silence ask, "God, show me the way."

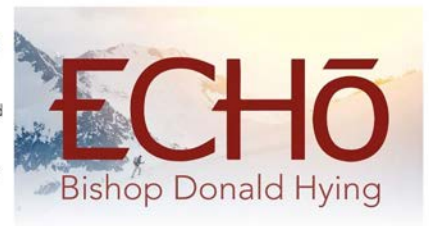

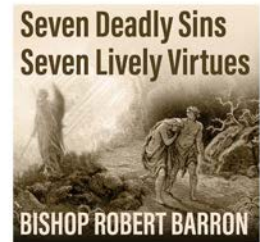

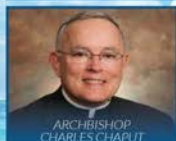
