BASEBALL GETS WIN AT COMERICA PARK; GIRLS SOCCER STARTS YEAR WITH TWO VICTORIES

SOFTBALL GETS SWEEP OVER FLINT POWERS

The Notre Dame Varsity Softball team improved to 5-1 on the season with a pair of wins over Flint Powers. In the opener, Sophomore Ryann Simmonds picked up her second win of the season as the Irish earned a 7-2 victory. Simmonds gave up two runs (one earned) on six hits while striking out four. Offensively, Notre Dame was led by Elena Schwegman with two hits and three runs scored. Junior Jordan Smith added a two-run home run to go along with four total RBI and also threw out the only Charger runner who attempted to steal a base. In the nightcap, Freshman Ani Wachowiak picking up her third win and second shutout of the season, giving up two hits and striking out three as the Irish won 12-0 in five innings. Schwegman added two more hits, both of which were home runs and included a grand slam, to finish with five RBI. Smith had another home run, scored twice, and stole a base. Ella Easterwood had three hits and score a run, Alina Stanczak had a run scored and RBI, and Wachowiak helped her own cause with a grand slam and two runs scored.

After falling behind 1-0 through four innings, the Irish responded in the bottom of the fifth inning with a Jacob Kalil two RBI base hit to grab a 2-1 lead. Notre Dame would add five runs in the sixth innings, the final two coming courtesy of a Michael Keoleian single, to put the game away.

IRISH SWEEP DOUBLEHRADER OVER BLOOMFIELD

The Notre Dame Varsity Softball team earned a doubleheader sweep over Bloomfield Hills, taking the opening game 19-6 and the second game 19-0. In the opener, the Irish took a 4-0 lead in the top of the first inning before the Black Hawks came roaring back to score six and take a 6-4 lead. However, the lead did not last long as starting pitcher AniWachowiak helped her own cause in the top of the second

inning with a three-run home run over the center field fence. The home run was the first for Wachowiak in her career and what proved to be the game winning RBI. Senior shortstop Elena Schwegman hit for the cycle and adding an additional home run. Schwegman finished a perfect five-for-five with five runs scored and four RBI. Meaghan Orloski had three doubles, scoring three times and plating four runs. Wachowiak picked up the win in the circle, giving up six runs on nine hits while striking out two. The second game ended after three as the Irish continued their torrid hitting pace. Jordan Smith had three hits, including a home run and two doubles, three runs scored, and five RBI. Orloski hit her first homer of the season, scoring twice and driving in four. Ryann Simmonds added a pair of hits, scored three times and drove in three while Schwegman scored four more runs. Wachowiak got the win, facing the minimum of nine batters and yielding only a walk.
