SCREENING



When students arrive at school, they must go through a screening station. [Click here for screening locations and times.](#)

Students will have their temperature taken, a visual check, and will have to show their QR code. If parents/guardians have not completed the iPass questionnaire, students will have to go to another screening table to go through the screening process manually.

Once a student has completed has completed all of the necessary steps, they will put their lanyard with their ID around their neck.

If a student arrives after period 1, then they must go to the screening station in the front of the school.



HAND HYGIENE

Washing hands and using hand sanitizer on a regular basis must be done by students and staff. Not only are there portable hand washing stations throughout our campus, over 25 of our classrooms have functioning sinks. And, each classroom and office space has hand sanitizer mounted on the wall.
