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RHMS Families,

We are very excited to have students back in person starting April 19th. Here are some of the Frequently Asked Questions we've received so far:

Did the Bell Schedule change again? Is it different for Remote students vs. In-Person students?

Yes. You can find the printable version of the full schedule on our RHMS website. Live instruction will take place between 8:00 am and 1:15 pm. Students have the ability to get help from teachers remotely M, T, TH, F from 1:30 – 2:10pm. Mondays and Thursdays students will have class periods 1, 3, and 5. Tuesdays and Fridays, students will have class periods 2, 4, and 6.

| Remote Student Work Time and Time for Help | 1:30 – 2:10 |

When can my student get help from a teacher?

On M, T, Th, F from 1:30 -2:10 teachers will be available to help students via Teams. On Wednesdays, teachers are available to help students from 10:00 – 11:00 am and from 11:30 – 1:30pm. Wednesdays will stay asynchronous. This means students will have work to complete, but will not have live instruction to attend.

I selected remote/in-person for my child and now I would like remote/in-person, can I change it?

Why did my student's P.E. teacher change?

We believe students will best be served through a model where the P.E. class is either fully remote or fully in person. Your student will keep the same schedule and the same class period of P.E., but depending on if your family selected "remote" or "in-person" learning, your student will be assigned the "remote" or "in person" class as well.

Can my student still buy lunch?

Lunches will be made available for free for all students who want them. No breakfast will be provided. Students can bring their lunch, but no microwaves will be provided, so all food needs to be available to eat "as is".
