

## RHMS COVID Safety Return to School Quick Sheet

As students return to school, please use this sheet to address and answer your return to school questions. Student safety is paramount at Rose Hill and Stella Schola.

### Face Covering and Hand Washing

Masks are required to be worn at all times, including: on the bus, waiting in line for attestation, outside, in class. Masks will be able to be removed during lunch, but students must remain seated and maintain 6 feet social distance during their 30 minute lunch. All students will be provided with two cloth masks.

Hand washing and sanitizing is the most effective way to combat spread of Covid. Students will wash hands whenever going to the restroom. Students will use hand sanitizer before entering a classroom and as they leave a classroom.

We know that middle schoolers sometimes forget to follow through with directions, so we will remind students as often as we need to do so. If a student willfully refuses to wear a mask after an adult reminds the student, our administrators will call the family to have the student picked up from school. ### Attestation and Arrival

A completed Student Attestation Form is required for entry into school each day. Students must complete a health check each morning to attest that they have no symptoms of Covid-19 or had contact with people who have tested positive for Covid-19. Students will have their temperature taken as they enter the building.

Each grade level will be entering at their own designated doorway to expedite attestation.

- 6<sup>th</sup> grade—Main Entrance
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade—Lower Gym Entrance
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade—South Door Entrance

To ease traffic congestion please do not drop off your students directly at their designated door; drive around the loop and drop off near the front of the building. If your student is walking or you are dropping your student off, please have your student arrive as close to 8:00 as possible.

### When to Keep Your Child Home

The most common symptoms per Centers for Disease Control include: fever of 100.4 or above, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, fatigue, muscle pain or body aches, headache, lost sense of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, and/or other signs of new illness that are unrelated to a documented preexisting condition. If you, your student, or member of your household is sick please keep your student home. If you, your student, or member of your household test positive for COVID-19, please notify the school right away.

### If your student displays symptoms of COVID at School

- Student will be escorted to a safe Q-room, a staff member will remain with them.
- You will be notified to pick up your student as soon as possible.
- Student will be brought to you once you arrive at the school.
- The school nurse will be in contact with you to gather more information and give you a return to school date.  
**Your student cannot return to school without being approved by the school nurse.**
