Course audit	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Year 10 – Paper 1 (Writing)▪ Year 10 – Paper 2 (Writing) ▪ Introduction to the Spoken Language Component▪ Spoken Language ideas presented on ‘No Pens Day Wednesday’ (25th November 2020)
New content	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Paper 1 (Reading section)▪ Paper 1 (Writing section) - Revision▪ Spoken Language presentations (performance)
Next steps	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ More engagement with the Weekend Read (a newspaper article sent out every Saturday to expose students to topical and relevant global issues and the writer’s craft) ▪ Improve all aspects of literacy, especially in reading and writing ▪ Expose students to better study skills and approaches

In-class assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A combination of oral responses, quizzes, question and answer and written tasks. ▪ Question by question teaching, with self and peer assessment opportunities
Interventions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Writing Intervention (focus on Paper 2, as planned in Autumn 2) ▪ Intervention will be organised into targeted groups based on PIXL Wave 1 exam analysis ▪ Teacher led intervention for Spoken Language assessment
Additional sessions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Resources will be given to Year 11 Form Tutors to use during PM registration ▪ Easter revision will run, as per interest ▪ Content will be revision strategies and the use of AQA exam past papers as resources (Paper 1)
Non-Examined Assessment (NEA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Spoken Language (Presentation of students' choice) ▪ Students may need to use intervention time or dedicated drop down time ▪ The presentations will be co-ordinated by members of the English team and not necessarily Year 11 class Teachers ▪ Students may be filmed and a sample set to AQA (TBC)
