	<ul> <li>For the after school session on Monday, we will focus on composing component.</li> <li>Sessions will run whenever Music is timetabled – 3.30-4.30</li> <li>We will focus mainly on Composition</li> <li>All students will be required to attend</li> <li>Reminders for the interventions will be done in lessons with a phone call home.</li> <li>All students will complete at least one composition by the end April</li> </ul>
Additional sessions	<ul> <li>Additional sessions on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> April and possible on the 14<sup>th</sup> April.</li> <li>I (VOD) will be in school</li> <li>The sessions are for everyone.</li> <li>The students will be working on their compositions</li> </ul>

Non-Examined Assessment (NEA)	<ul> <li>Performing (NEA) – Completed in school on the 26<sup>th</sup> March.</li> <li>Composition (NEA) is coursework based and has to be completed in school and supervised (13<sup>th</sup> April and possibly 14<sup>th</sup> April)</li> <li>If the MACs and software are still unavailable we might need 2/3 days to focus solely on completing the composing component (TBC)</li> </ul>
