Non-Examined Assessment (NEA)	 The speaking assessment this year will be an NEA These are yet to be completed and will be completed by an outside examiner Pupils will complete a speaking recording home for assessment This will be a photocard, role play and speaking questions- pupils will be given the tasks and questions to record answers to Communication home will be necessary to ensure that all pupils understand its importance.
Range of evidence	 All previous mock papers will be used An additional past paper will be completed Pupils can prepare for them by completing the revision activities on Kerboodle, learning the relavent vocabulary on Memrise, grammar revision on <u>www.languagesonline.org.uk</u>, videos on GCSE Pod 3 writing tasks will also be taken into consideration- one translation from Italian into English, one translation into Italian and one free writing task These will be set on topics from across the syllabus Pupils will have a choice of 2 questions for each writing task They will follow the appropriate task for the tier of entry
Formal assessments	 Pupils will complete a full mock paper- listening, reading and writing (3 papers in total) As this is a home language, there is no formal teaching and therefore the specially released AQA papers will be used Where possible, all 3 papers should be conducted centrally (as there is no class time available) Pupils will know that the papers will cover all topics

Other information	 Pupils should learn the vocabulary which is to be made available to them
