

## Park Use Guidelines

- **Dogs are prohibited** from the park, farm and trails for the safety of the farm animals, wildlife and visitors.
- **Picnicking is prohibited** except in conjunction with a park sponsored program.
- **Biking on trails is prohibited.**
- **Food and drinks are prohibited at the farm.**
- **Do not feed or pet the farm animals.**
- Do not release any wildlife in the park without prior permission.
- Do not remove any natural items: animals, plants or plant parts.
- All public motorized vehicles are prohibited on the trails.
- No open fires except in conjunction with a park sponsored program.
- Hunting, trapping, archery, fireworks, firearms, BB guns, sling shots and paintball guns are prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the park.
- Smoking is prohibited in all buildings and at the farm.
- Organized groups who wish to use the park facilities must schedule a program or make prior arrangements with the office before coming.

## Westmoor Park

Westmoor Park is a 162 acre, Town of West Hartford, Human and Leisure Services Department facility. It is the largest public park in town. A popular attraction at the park is the demonstration farm, which is home to a variety of barnyard animals.

Westmoor Park is funded entirely through the Charles and Leila Hunter Trust Fund, the Westmoor Park Fund, program fees, donations and grants. No public tax dollars are used to meet annual operational expenses for the park.

## Trail Map Use

### The Trails

The handicapped accessible, gravel surfaced, self guided nature trail loop is measured beginning and ending from the gate at the lower/south end of the parking lot. All other trail distances are measured from their connection with the gravel surfaced trail loop.

**Handicapped Accessible,  
Self Guided Nature Discovery Trail**  
5,254 feet = .99 miles

**Maple Swamp Trail**  
1,452 feet = .28 miles

**Woodland Wildflower Trail**  
2,052 feet = .39 miles

**Loop Trail**  
2,470 feet = .47 miles

**Wet Meadow Trail**  
2,134 feet = .40 miles

One loop around the wildflower meadow (with the flagpole in the middle) is 1,820 feet or .34 miles.

### Nature Trail Mission and Hours

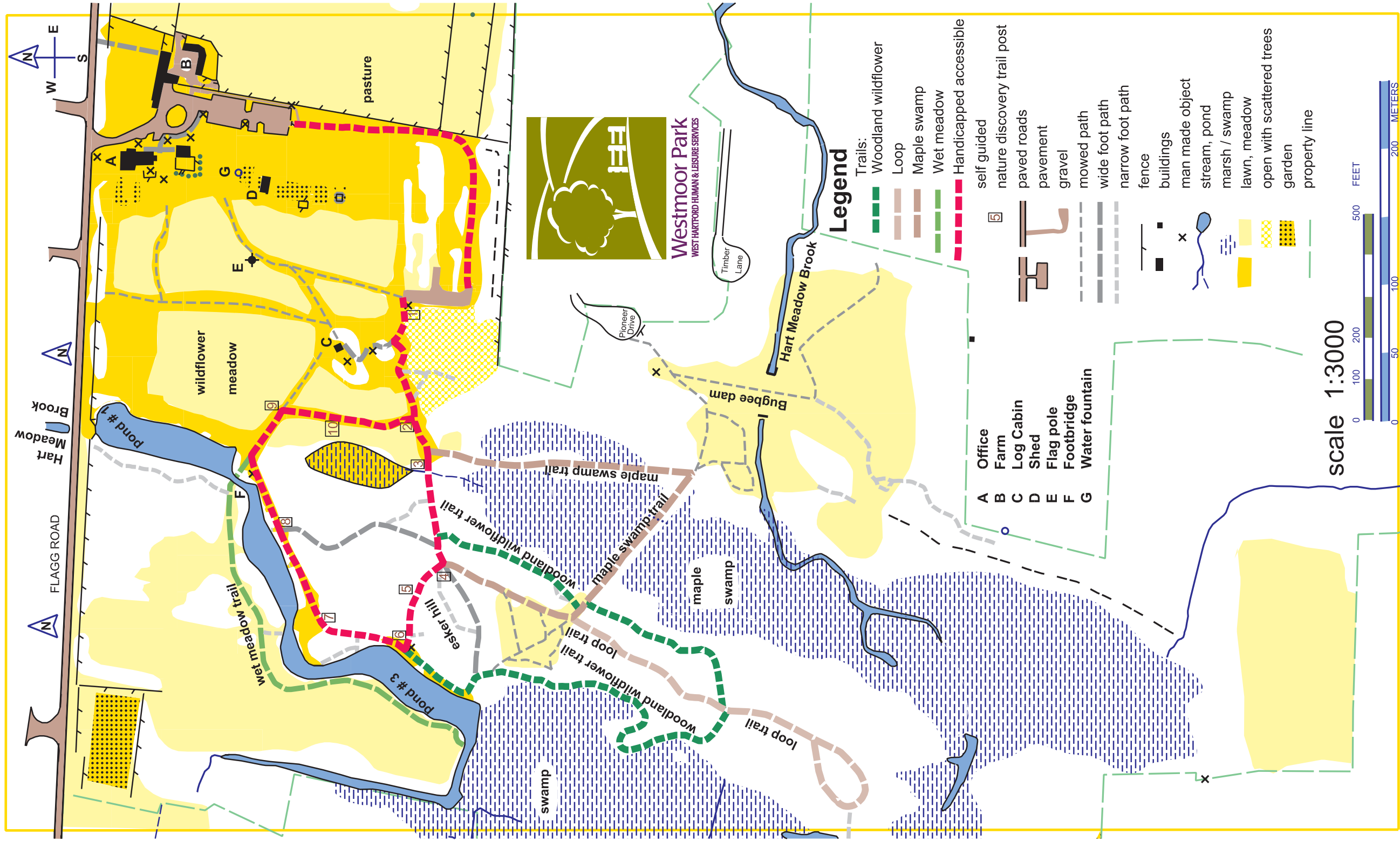
Westmoor Park's trail system provides people with the opportunity to enjoy the wonders of nature in a safe, easily accessible area. Take only pictures, leave only footprints.

- The trails and park grounds are open for walking and passive recreation from 7:00 a.m. to dusk.
- The farm is open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
