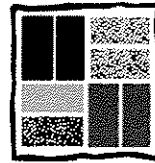

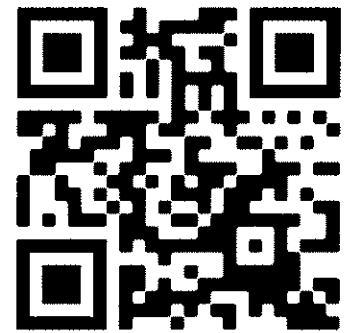


Pedro Zamora Young Leaders Scholarship

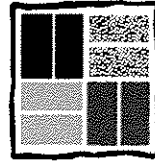
Eligibility

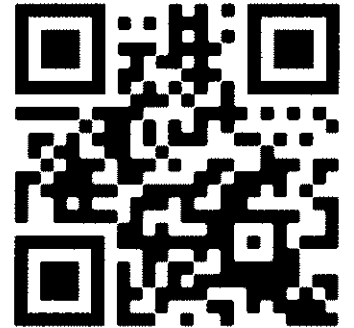


Mary Bowman Arts in Activism Award

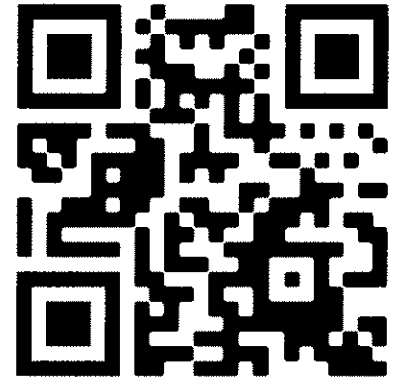

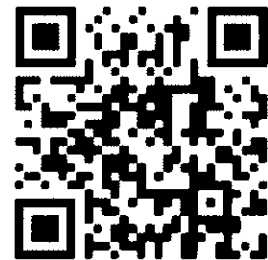

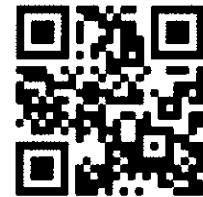
