

Got Drugs? Don't Flush!

It is important that we work together to safely discard any unused or unwanted medications.

What to know how to properly discard prescription medication:

- 1. Remove all medications from plastic pill container (unless location requires, call first), place in a plastic zip lock bag and drop off at any drop box or bin provided.**
 - 2. For the protection of your identity, remove all labels with personal information from plastic pill container: name, address and phone number.**
 - 3. Save the Planet: recycle plastic pill container**
- Prescription medication can be harmful if shared with other people who are not the prescribed patient, or if the prescribed patient misuses their own prescription medication.**

Medications such as opioids and cough syrups have a high risk of misuse and could lead to addiction if not monitored by a physician.

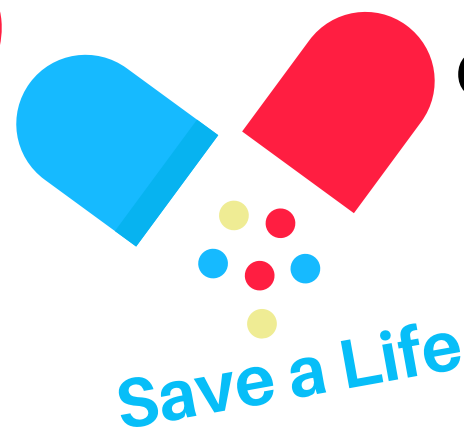
