

# A message from the Director of Development

Dear SRDS Community,

What a tumultuous year it has been! We are extremely proud of the resiliency and commitment of our faculty and staff in delivering a COVID-19 action plan that prioritized the health and safety of the community while delivering a high quality education.

In response to the unexpected expenses resulting from the pandemic, the COVID-19 Response Fund was created to offset investments in 3 key areas:

- •Health & Safety -- investments in PPE (hand sanitizers, wipes, cleaning supplies, Plexiglas shields, and other protective equipment), mandated campus renovations, air filtration, new cleaning protocols, and hiring of additional staff.
- •Technology -- increased bandwidth, internet and electrical upgrades, and equipment and software purchases (cameras, monitors, smart boards, document cameras, headsets, iPads, Chrome books, Zoom).
- •Need-based Financial Aid -- investments in need-based aid increased by 5% and the number of families receiving aid increased by 4%.

This past fall the Development Office introduced this fund to a select group of donors whose generosity enabled us to offset a significant portion of our COVID-related expenses. Yet some of these expenses will continue into the 2021-2022 school year, and that is why the Parents Guild has graciously chosen to donate the proceeds from tonight's Vine & Basket event to the COVID-19 Response Fund.

We are immensely grateful for the support of the Parents Guild and the entire SRDS community for coming together for the benefit of our students. A very special thank you goes to the Vine & Basket committee

for the work they have done to create this amazing event!

I hope you enjoy this beautiful evening. It is a wonderful opportunity for our community to get back together again -- something we all hope to see much more of in the near future!


# **DAN PULZELLO**
