5:30 Call to order

Allen volunteered to Chair the committee, Tina volunteered to be minute taker.

Wendy asked the group if there were any topics of interest we would like to explore. She gave an overview of everything that determines curriculum such as State standards, assessments, professional development, data analysis, and grant work. Data is coming in from teachers and she will update us soon with that information. Some of that information reflects the differences in two-day, four-day, and remote learning.

She explained the importance of flexible pathways at the high school level.

Chasity asked about the challenges of the SBACs this year. Wendy explained that while scores may be down in science, literacy, and math, we are still required to do the testing because it is federally mandated. There is, however, a chance we could qualify for a waiver due to the challenges with hybrid learning.

Tina brought up flexible pathways. Wendy explained the importance of programs such as EPIC and learning through working. She commented that Jeremy Scannell was working on a grant that would fund a youth employment specialist. She said we need to be creative not only in our core courses, but also in our electives, especially for our juniors and seniors.

Stephanie commended the EPIC program and said she would love to see the pod method used in some capacity even after students return to full-time in-person learning.
