53 due to additional COVID-19 federal relief funds, the specifics will be discussed at future board
54 meetings.

55 RESOLUTION

56 Be it resolved that the School Board of the St. Anthony – New Brighton School District approve
57 the following right sizing budget items:

58
59 Right size Wilshire Park Elementary School by reducing expenses by \$97,646 for the 2021-
60 2022 school year by eliminating one classroom section due to decline in enrollment.

61
62 ISD282 will reduce expenses by \$75,037 for the 2021-2022 school year by reducing Para
63 educator/Clerical hours due to decline in enrollment.

64
65 ISD282 will reduce expenses by \$29,582 for the 2021-22 school year by reducing custodial
66 hours. This reduction will take place by not hiring an open portion of a current position.

67
68 **A motion was made by Leah Slye and seconded by Ben Phillip to approve the Right**
69 **Sizing Budget Resolution, as presented. With a roll call vote, the motion carries 6-0.**

72 **2. Unrequested Leave Placement – Teaching Overages**
73

74 The Administration recommended that the Board place nine (9) continuing contract teachers
75 (*Andrew Otis; Jennifer Patrek; Jon Veitengruber; Heather Berndt; Luke Tressel; Joan Nelson;*
76 *Julie Miller; Lori Watzl-King; and Jennifer Kuykendall*) on Unrequested Leave of Absence for an
77 overage placement during the 2020-21 school year.

78 The teachers named are on an Unrequested Leave of Absence from their 2020-21 teaching
79 overage. The teachers will remain teaching at their continuing contract status.

80
81 **A motion was made by Cassandra Palmer and seconded by Lynne Penke Valdes to**
82 **approve the Unrequested Leave Placement – Teaching Overages, as presented. With a**
83 **roll call vote, the motion carries 6-0.**

86 The Administration recommended that the Board place one (1) continuing contract teacher on
87 Unrequested Leave of Absence.

88 The School Board of Independent School District No. 282 adopted the resolution placing *Jodi*
89 *Mandyck (.70 FTE)* on unrequested leave of absence on April 6, 2021, on the grounds of
90 discontinuance of position.

92 **A motion was made by Ben Phillip and seconded by Leah Slye to approve the**
93 **Unrequested Leave Placement of Jodi Mandyck, as presented. With a roll call vote, five**
94 **(5) yes and one (1) abstain by Lynne Penke Valdes, the motion carries 5-1.**
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3. Non-Renewals

The Administration recommended that the contracts for *Joe Anderson (.1); Karl Griffin (1.0); Derrick Rink (.1); and Rebecca Zimmerman (.2): four (4) probationary teachers, be terminated on June 14, 2021.*

The School Board of Independent School District No. 282, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 122A.40 Subd. 5, adopted the resolution that the teaching contracts of probationary teachers *Joe Anderson (.1); Karl Griffin (1.0); Derrick Rink (.1); and Rebecca Zimmerman (.2) in Independent School District 282 are hereby terminated at the close of the current session and are not renewed for the 2021-2022 school year.*

A motion was made by Cassandra Palmer and seconded by Barry Kinsey to approve the Certified Probationary Non-Renewals, as presented. With a roll call vote, the motion carries 6-0.
