You Must ACT NOW to Complete Intent to Return Instructional Model Form

Dear Drew Parents/Guardians:

We are sending this communication to announce that Drew Charter School plans to implement two instructional models for the 2021 – 2022 school year:

- Drew will return to a **full five-day**, **in-person model** starting the first day of the new school year. The in-person model will be implemented in accordance with CDC recommendations for schools.
- Drew will also offer a full, five-day virtual* model for the first semester of the new year (July through December 2021) for Kindergarten through 12th grade students unable to participate in the in-person model.

*Drew's Virtual model is pending required approval by Atlanta Public Schools.

Note: The 2021 - 2022 instructional model options for Pre-K students has not yet been determined.

To assist in planning for the upcoming school year, all parents/guardians must complete an **Intent to Return Instructional Model Selection Form**, by April 29th, to select their student's instructional model for the first semester of the new school year.

While a link to the Intent to Return Form is included later in this message, we will first share information about our initial plans for implementing instruction for the upcoming school year:

- Under both models, students will receive full instruction all day, five days a week with an anticipated after-care option for Pre-K through 7th grades.
- In-person instruction will continue to align with CDC recommendations and other best practice COVID-mitigation protocols, including wearing masks, social distancing, routine testing and other strong COVID-mitigation safety protocols to protect the wellbeing of students, staff, and families.
- For virtual learners, Drew will offer either the Atlanta Virtual Academy (<u>AVA click here for more information</u>) or a virtual model using Drew teachers. It is not anticipated that Drew teachers will instruct virtual and in-person students simultaneously.
- While we hope to accommodate all interested students, if more students select Drew's in-person model
 than Drew can safely accommodate in accordance with CDC recommendations, the school may need
 to shift some students to the virtual model.
