### English

We will be launching our new topic Tiger, Tiger within the book, Pattan's Pumpkin, an Indian flood story. The children will be developing their descriptive language as they describe the characters Pattan and his wife Kanni face the elements of the storm. They will also be writing in the style of news reporter as they report upon the flood and how the characters Pattan and Kanni protect their belongings and animals.



Maths

We will be learning to multiply numbers and then divide by sharing a given number into equal groups. We will also be exploring halves and quarters of objects or quantities. We will be continuing to count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals, partitioning into tens and ones.

## RE

We will be naming and recognising religious objects and practices in Hinduism.



We will also be comparing the similarities between the Islamic festival of Eid al-Fitr and other festivals.

#### Music

We will be recapping pulse and



rhythm, as well as learning all about pitch. We will be identifying high and low sounds and using our voices to chant, sing and rap.

#### Science

We will be learning all about plants this term. First we will find out about the structure of plants and trees, finding out the function of each part (such as the stem, root and flower). We will also learn the names of many common plants that grow in the local area too. We will be conducting fascinating experiments too.



#### ΡE

In PE we will be exploring dancing, learning how to Bhangra dance.

We will be learning how to make chapattis.

We will be designing our chapatti, choosing the filling we wish to add and then evaluating our delicious, finished product.



# Computing

We will be using purple mash to help us to learn all about how to create and use pictograms, using them to answer questions. We will also be discovering how to use spreadsheets, learning how to add data into cells, how to calculate by inputting information and how to use the copy and paste feature too.

### Geography
