Textbook & Device Return for AHS & Virtual Campus

Virtual Campus Seniors

May 11th, May 12th & 13th anytime 7:00-3:00.

Please return all **devices** to the AHS main office with your name on it. Please return **textbooks and novels** on the cart in the vestibule outside the AHS Main Office. Label all books with your name on a sticky note.

Graduation Requirements

If your senior will not be completing his/her graduation requirements by **May 21st** he/she cannot participate in commencement. Please contact his/her counselor to make the necessary arrangements for completion of these requirements.

Final Transcripts Requests

You must request your final transcript through your Parchment account. Failure to do so may cause colleges to place a hold on your account.

Senior Walk

The Senior Walk will be Monday, May 17th. Seniors should bring their cap and gown and report to the main gym at 11:45 am. We recommend parents arrive at the football field between 12:30 - 1:00 pm. We anticipate the Senior Walk starting at approximately 1:00 pm. Once the seniors have completed their final walk inside the building, they will continue their walk to the football field.

Cap & Gown Distribution for AHS & Virtual Campus:

On **Thursday, April 29th**, Josten's will be at AHS to pass out graduation regalia in the auxiliary gym.

In-person seniors may pick up their items during their lunch period.

Virtual Campus seniors may pickup anytime between 9:45 am—12:15 pm; enter through the athletic entrance.

Extra tassels will be available at a cost of \$13 each (one tassel is included with the purchase of a gown). Gowns, caps, and tassels remain the property of the graduate.
