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Dear Parents:

We invite your children to spend their summer at CAMP IDS 2021. This summer camp is staffed by Corbett Prep's dedicated, dynamic, and highly skilled directors and counselors. Option 1 - Campers can bring cash to purchase snacks and drinks as needed.

Option 2 - Weekly lunches are available to purchase in CampSite for a \$35 weekly fee. Please note that lunches must be purchased by the Friday prior to camp starting.

## CAMP IDS Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I register my child/children?

A: Visit [www.corbettprep.com](http://www.corbettprep.com) and click on CAMP IDS banner to access the registration link.

Q: What are my payment options?

A: In order to guarantee your camper a place at camp, all camps must be paid in full upon registration.

Q: What is the CAMP IDS refund policy?

A: Prior to May 3, 2021, ALL payments are fully refundable. On or after May 3, 2021, 50% of the FULL payment will be refunded ONLY if requested 10 days prior to the start of that camp.

Q: What will full-day campers do between their morning and afternoon camps?

A: Full-day campers have a 30-minute supervised lunch/snack period during morning and afternoon camps.

Q: Is lunch provided?

A: Campers can bring their lunch from home. Pre-purchased lunches from Warriors' Oasis Café are available for a weekly cost of \$35.00. Lunches must be purchased by the Friday prior to camp starting. Campers may bring cash to purchase snacks or drinks from Warriors' Oasis Café daily. Students in full-day camps that travel offsite (Adventure Camp, Rockin' Rec, Teen Rec and Wilderness Extreme) will need to bring lunch from home. Purchased lunches are only available to students attending camps that remain at Corbett Prep.

Q: Is transportation provided?

A: Families can purchase weekly round-trip transportation for \$35 per camper. Our stops are in South Tampa, New Tampa, and Westchase. Trips are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE on or after May 3, 2021.

Q: Do campers need to wear their CAMP IDS shirts every day?

A: Wearing the CAMP IDS shirt is OPTIONAL. Additional shirts will be available for purchase. Campers are encouraged to wear their CAMP IDS shirt on Fridays for Spirit Day.

\*All campers receive a complimentary CAMP IDS shirt on their first week of camp.

Q: In which grade level are campers placed?

A: Specified grade levels are the grades that campers will be entering in the 2021-2022 school year.

Q: What happens if I need to change camps or the weeks that my child attends camp?

A: Prior to May 3, 2021, families can call or email the camp office to have changes made to their child's schedule free of a penalty fee. On or after May 3, 2021, there is a \$30 change-fee per each camp that is changed.

Q: What if I am late picking up my child from camp?

A: All campers picked up after 3:15p.m. will be charged \$12 for extended aftercare which is offered until 6:00pm Monday through Friday. Charges will be made to the card used during the camp registration process.

Q: What if I need extended aftercare for my child?

A: You may purchase extended aftercare for your child for \$60 per week. This includes a snack and supervised play throughout our beautiful campus. Daily extended aftercare is available for \$12 per day, and registration takes place by phone during the week of camp that your child will attend. On or after May 3, 2021, all extended aftercare is NON-REFUNDABLE.

**NEW** **MARVEL MYSTERIES AND PRINCESS POWERS** Grades: (1-4)..... Week 1  
Fly high, test your strength and design superpowered structures based on the most famous DC and Marvel comics! Use STEAM concepts to create powerful princess structures! Challenge your princess and superhero power to engineer your way through classic and modern tales.

**MINECRAFT** Grades: (4-8)..... Week 6  
Get ready for an adventure of the digital kind! Younger campers will learn about mining and crafting and will have problems to solve during their adventure. More advanced campers will be challenged to work together on quests and solve the mysteries of the castle and may even explore mods! Offline creative activities will provide additional imaginative experiences. No Minecraft account is needed. This camp will use an in-house LAN, so the kids will not access the Internet, but they will all see each other in the world.

**NEW** **MULTIMEDIA MANIA** Grades: (2-5)..... Week 5  
Create and design your own multimedia videos that combine text, audio, graphics, animations, images, or video! Campers will use computer applications to get creative with filters, special effects, lighting, transitions, speed, voice over and so much more! Combine your tech and creative skills while you have fun taking your videos to the next level!

**VIDEO GAME DESIGN** Grades: (2-4)..... Week 2  
Want to learn how to make your own Mario-style video game? You will learn that and more as you program characters, edit backgrounds, and make all the rules for your own digital animation or game! All campers will take home a copy of their game to play on their home computer.

## Visual Arts Camps

**NEW** **ART EXPERIENCE FUN!** Grades: (K-2)..... Week 6  
Ever want to splash in a puddle of paint or draw with a broom? We will be making a joyful (washable) mess daily in this outdoor class where we physically experience the creation of art. From colorful bubbles and sidewalk chalk to walking through paint on a canvas, this will be a class for the fun-loving artist who likes to try out new things with artistic play. Please bring a towel and wear clothes that can be stained; this class will be about the daily experience of exploring color.

**NEW** **DRAWN TO LIFE: COMIC DESIGN** Grades: (3-5)..... Week 6  
Grades: (5-8)..... Week 5

POW! Do you enjoy reading comics like *Spiderman*, *Batman*, and *Peanuts*? Or how about reading manga anime like *Dragonball Z* or *Naruto*? If you answered yes to any of these questions, this is the class for you! Come to a week of creative fun where you learn how to create characters and how to create comic panels to tell a story. By the end of the camp you will have created your own original character along with your own comic book.

**FUN FURNITURE MAKEOVER** Grades: (3-6)..... Week 6  
Have a small piece of wooden furniture that needs some new life? Bring it to camp, and we'll help you turn it into your own personal work of art. After sketching out ideas, campers will sand their piece of furniture, prime it, and then get creative with color and design. Please bring an oversized paint shirt and a small item to refinish.

**MASTERPIECE ARTISTS** Grades: (K-2) ..... Week 1  
Grades: (3-6) ..... Weeks 1,3

Van Gogh, Cezanne, Seurat, O'Keefe, DaVinci – come learn about the lives of these master artists and their works! We'll explore their styles and techniques, and then camp artists will create their own masterpieces. They will experiment with a variety of mediums including watercolor, soft pastels, temperas, and charcoals. Please bring an oversized paint shirt.

**MINIATURE WORLDS** Grades: (3-5) ..... Weeks 2,5  
Grades: (6-8) ..... Week 2

When is an Altoid tin more than a tin? In this camp, the tin transforms into a miniature world! Campers will use their creativity to dream, design and build in miniature, using everyday objects in a completely new way. This is a place where paper clips get twisted into café chairs, and plastic sushi grass gets clipped into a field. Using everything from pliers to paintbrushes, campers will love this multimedia experience. Please wear clothes suitable for all manner of creative expression.

**MULTIMEDIA SCULPTURE** Grades: (3-5) ..... Weeks 1,3

Enjoy a week of sculpting with clay, molding found materials, wrapping papier-mâché, and twisting wire. We will explore the arts from a 3D perspective. Campers are encouraged to bring unique objects from home that need a new purpose. We will explore the influences of artists like Calder, Rauschenberg, and Bourgeois, to name a few. Comfortable "art" clothes are best for this camp of exploration into the art of multimedia.

**NEW** **OUT OF THE BOX: SCULPTURE** Grades: (3-6) ..... Week 4  
Grades: (5-8) ..... Week 3

In this clever sculpture camp, we think outside the box! Come learn how to create huge 3D sculptures using cardboard, paint, tape, and hot glue. We will also construct sculptures of found things in nature. Come explore the principles of sculpture and design some out-of-the-box art!

**PHOTO FUN!** Grades: (K-5) ..... Weeks 2,6  
Grades: (5-8) ..... Weeks 2,6

During this week, campers will work with natural light. They will learn how to use the sun and sky as a tool to emphasize details in their environment. Campers will work with shadows, water reflections, and giant bubbles. They will learn about aperture, shutter speed, and composition through the eye of the camera. Campers may use their own digital camera or may borrow a camera during each day's activities.

**NEW** **PRINTMAKING: BLOCK PRINTING** Grades: (5-8) ..... Week 4

Learn to create works of art in a fun environment using a variety of printmaking methods. Students will explore relief, mono-print and gelli prints to create prints that use expression, abstraction and realism. Some prints will be transformed into mixed media.

**RECYCLE ART** Grades: (K-2) ..... Weeks 2,4

Care for the earth and explore your creativity. We'll make two- and three-dimensional works of art by building, sculpting, painting, and repurposing recycled items. Each camper will construct a recycled friend, such as a robot, animal or insect! Campers will also collaborate on an earth-friendly group project. Please bring an oversized paint shirt.

**TRENDING ART** Grades: (3-5) ..... Week 2  
Grades: (6-8) ..... Week 5

If you have ever watched an art video online and thought, "I want to try that!" you'll want to check out this camp! We will explore different trending art techniques from melting crayons on canvas and stamping coins with fun sayings to stenciling with leaves and spray paint! This will be a mixed-media adventure to actually try out all those viral art videos and see what they are all about! Please wear clothes worthy of getting splattered, smudged, and oops'd with paint.

**YOUNG ARTISTS** Grades: (K-2) ..... Weeks 1,3,5

Would you like to splatter paint like Pollock? Create works inspired by impressionists such as Monet? Build a mobile like Calder? Create pop art like Warhol? Young artists will enjoy a journey of self-expression through art while experiencing a variety of mediums and art forms, including paint, three-dimensional building, collage, and clay sculpture. Please bring an oversized paint shirt.
