1. The minutes were reviewed and approved from the previous meeting.

Chris Brower motioned to approve the minutes and Brenda Bacon seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved.

2. School Improvement goals ( ACT, Graduation Rate, Pathways and Certification) along with the Action Plans were reviewed. Signature page was signed by all member in attendance.

4. Principal Swanson gave an update on graduation. Most recent information graduation will be June 2 at 1:00 at WSU. WSU has put some pretty strict restrictions that are still being worked out. Principal Swanson is hoping to have a letter out to parents next week. Principal Swanson shared that schools will be required to require masks until July 1. End of Year activities will be on May 14. A carnival will be during the day and a dance in the evening. All activities at end of year must only be FHS enrolled students. Test to graduate will cover all graduation/senior activities. Test on that Tuesday will cover activities, graduation, and all night party.

A question was asked about remote Fridays next year. Right now the calendar has us coming back to school on the pre-covid schedule with 5 days a week and late start Tuesdays. Another question was asked about graduation cords. Principal Swanson said we can certainly look at it.
