Year 13 Transition

I am writing to share the school's plans for the Year 13 students' transition to their next phase. Despite the challenges they've faced during their studies this academic year and last, we are determined that this half term is as successful and positive for them as it can be. Of course, it will see the final assessment and teaching of the A Level courses which will require a continued focus. These in-class assessments will provide teachers with the final evidence base with which to make a decision about your child's recommended final grade for each subject. The timetable for the assessments was emailed to parents and students before the Easter break.

We will not require students to attend full time from **Monday 7th June**. There will be ongoing work in school to finalise the teacher assessed grades for each subject. This *may* mean your child is asked to attend school at any time up to Friday 18th June (the final submission date for centre assessed grades). Please do not make arrangements to take your child on holiday during this time. Students will receive their results on Tuesday 10th August, more details regarding times and processes will be sent to parents and students closer to the time.

Normal lessons or assessments will take place up to Thursday 27th May. On Friday 28th May there will be a celebration morning to allow students to celebrate their time here at Kineton and mark the start of their transition into adult life. Students will participate in social events throughout the morning, organised by our student Social Committee and Head Boy and Girl team. Students will finish on this day at 12.30pm, and will be permitted to leave site. Please inform Miss Loveridge directly if you would like your child to remain on site until 2.45pm or if they will need to remain on site to utilise school transport.

We will continue to support all our students with future destinations as they remain on our roll until the end of August.
