- Only 2 books may be read from the same series or author.
- Only books worth 5 points or less may be counted toward summer reading. The purpose of this point restriction is to encourage you to read many good books during the summer.

*The point value can be determined by going to the website: <u>www.arbookfind.com</u> and typing in the title of your book. This website will also give information about the level of the books you choose.

Remember to have your parents initial your Summer Reading Record. When school starts in August, bring it to us. Your Summer Reading Record is due the second day of school.

You are required to make 10 points, but if you read more you will earn a medal.
