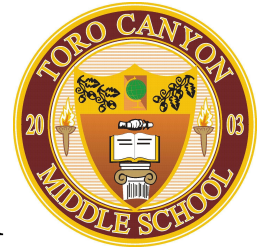

Benefits Of Creative Play At Home

What is creative play? It refers to recreation that stimulates curiosity and imagination, thus contributing to child development and manual skills. Examples : baking, singing, and drawing.

Benefits

Creative play can contribute to child development. It can promote physical and mental health, creativity, and social skills. It can also teach children to be patient, to improve their decision-making skills, to control their emotions, and to get along with others when playing with a group. In short, creative play can help prepare children for adulthood.

Overexposure to electronic media can be harmful. Too much exposure to digital media can be addictive, and exposure to too much of it has been linked to childhood obesity and aggressive behavior.
