



STUDENT DRESS CODE LARSON MIDDLE SCHOOL

Guidelines for student dress are outlined in the TSD Student Code of Conduct: <https://www.troy.k12.mi.us/students/student-code-of-conduct>

Larson students are expected to dress in compliance with the following guidelines:

- No bare midriffs are permitted. Shirts and tops must meet the waistline of jeans, pants, skirts or shorts (the “bottom of the top” should remain in contact with the “top of the bottom”).
- No backless or strapless tops are allowed.
- No see-through or otherwise revealing clothing is allowed.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Jeans, pants, skirts or shorts must provide adequate coverage and be of reasonable length.
- Tops and bottoms must conceal all undergarments.
- Non-prescription sunglasses should not be worn in the school environment.
- Chains, handcuffs, and other metal paraphernalia on clothing are prohibited.
- Hats, bandanas, hoods and other head coverings are not to be worn in school.
- Clothing must not display inappropriate slogans and/or graphics including those related to or depicting behavior prohibited in the Code of Conduct
