#### Different Musical Styles

# I'm ready...Let's Go! How do I sign up for BAND?

## Step One

Sign up for Band on the 6th Grade Enrollment Google Form that you received from the school.

# Step Two

Get to know the instruments again. Read through the Instrument Selection Form that was given to you at school! Then go to the band website and view the instruments to see and hear what may interest you!

## Step Three

Sign up for one-15 minute meeting with the student wanting to be in band and parent. You can pick a date from the following: May 3, 4, 5, 6, or 8 for all instruments except for Percussion. If you are interested in percussion, you must sign up for a meeting for all woodwind & brass AND then you sign up for a percussion meeting. The percussion meeting date is set for May 7th.
