

News From The Principal - Parent Teacher Conferences

We will be having our Parent Teacher conferences for our fourth quarter classes on **Thursday**, **April 22nd**, **from 3:30-7:30 pm**. We will be using the same conference format and process that we used for our first, second, and third quarter parent teacher conferences, utilizing Google appointment slots and Google meets. Yesterday you should have received an email from each of your student's teachers with directions on how to sign up for these conferences. If you are satisfied with your students' progress in class, don't feel compelled to sign up for a conference. We will have a limited amount of conference appointments available due to this format. These conferences really are for parents and teachers to discuss students who need additional support in the class, or if you have specific issues or questions that you want to address. If your student is doing great in the class and you have no issues to discuss, you really don't need to schedule a conference (and I mean that in the nicest, most positive way possible). Also, if you just have a quick question for a teacher, please feel free to send them an email directly.

Please note that you will need a gmail account in order to sign up for these appointment slots. If you do not currently have one, you can either create an account or use your student's school account (which is gmail based) to sign up and join the virtual conference.

I was born on the golden slopes of northeast lowa, raised amongst the cattle and corn. After graduating from Luther College and getting married, my wife and I moved to a small town in Alaska near Denali National Park and we taught at a small K-12 school. While there, I taught everything from high school math and science classes to health/P.E. and auto mechanics as well as a variety of other classes. We lived there for a 7-year period and built a home there with the help of a few other local Alaskans. A couple years into that 7 year period, my wife and I moved to Kenya to live with and serve children at a home and teach at their school.

In 2010, we moved to Colorado and I've been working at Centaurus teaching engineering classes ever since. I am actively involved in Cornerstone Church in Boulder and love to share the peace and joy that I have through my faith. Last year, our family moved to Uganda to serve a local pastor there in his development of a primary school. While there I taught business classes and provided educational training and health and sanitation training. Our family was evacuated last March due to COVID but we are excited to return for the month of July to continue working with our Ugandan friends.
