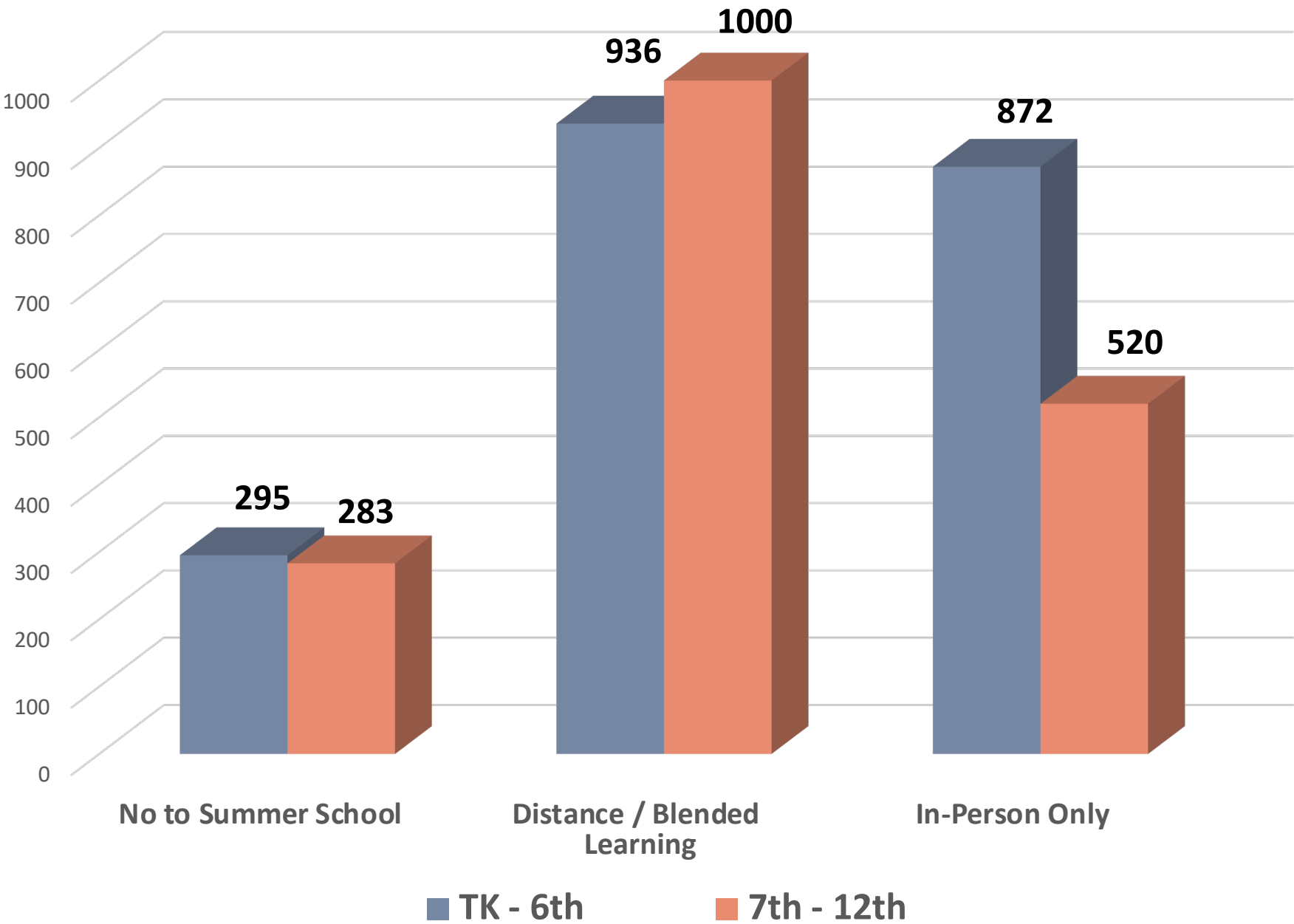

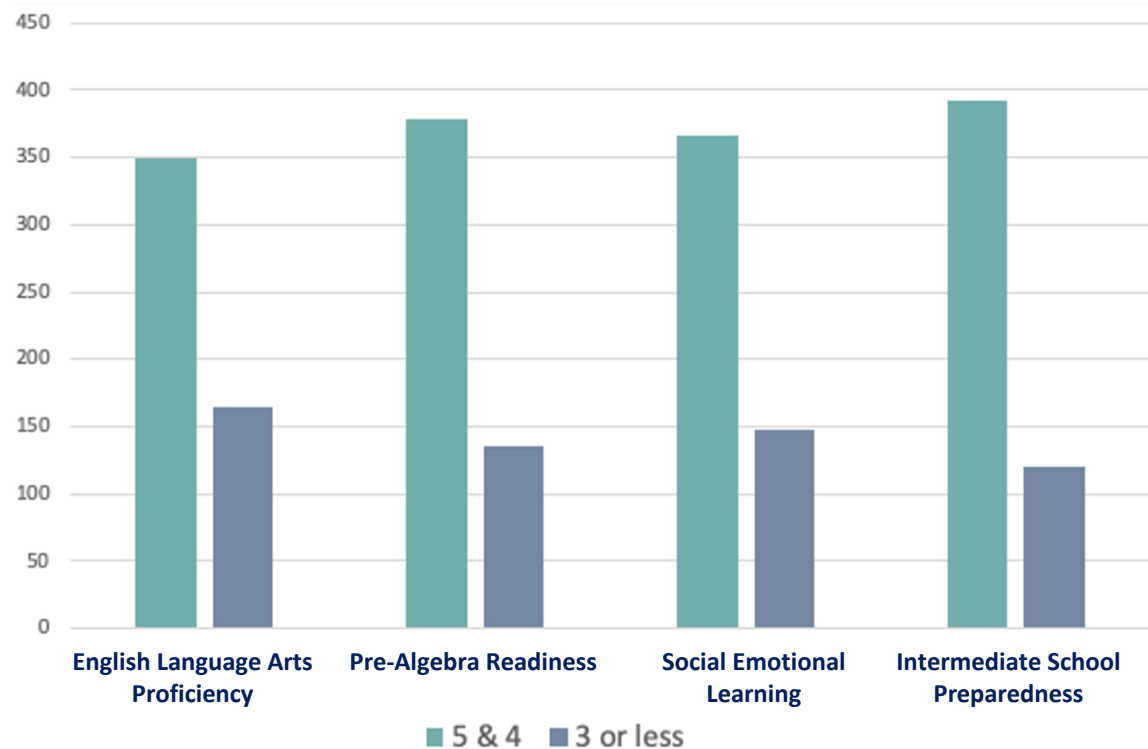

Grades 7th – 12th: 1803

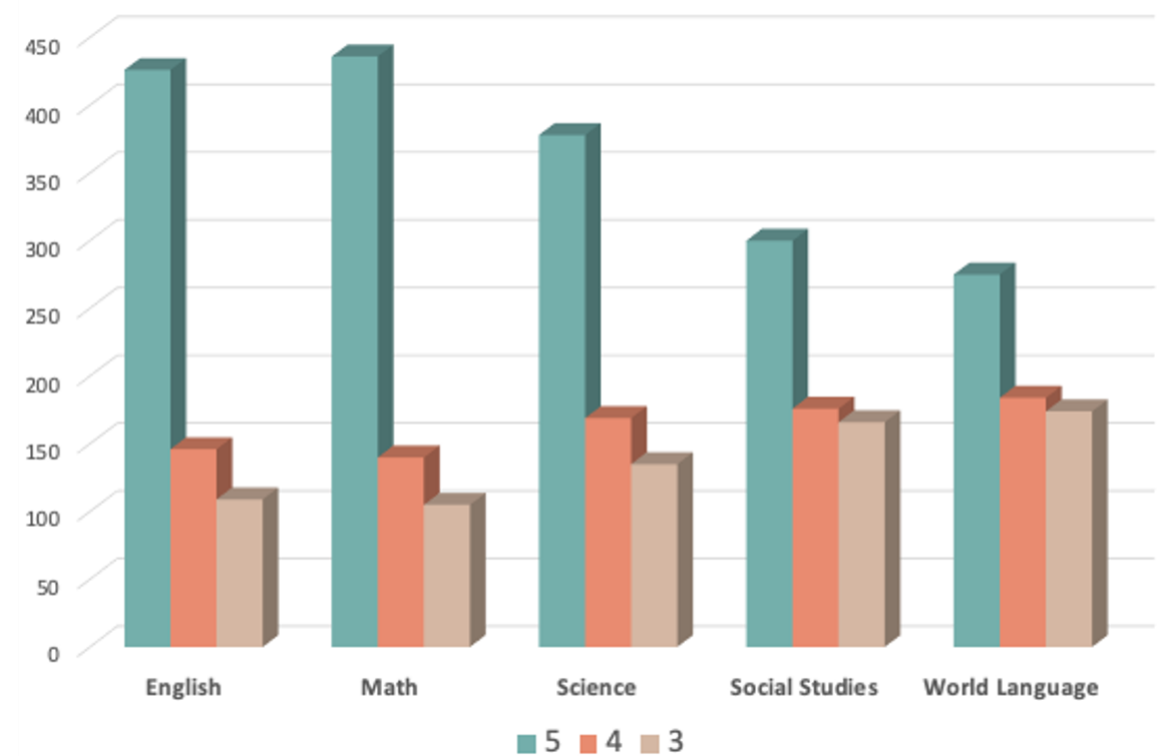


Parent Survey Results for Summer 2021

Expanded Learning Opportunities Grants

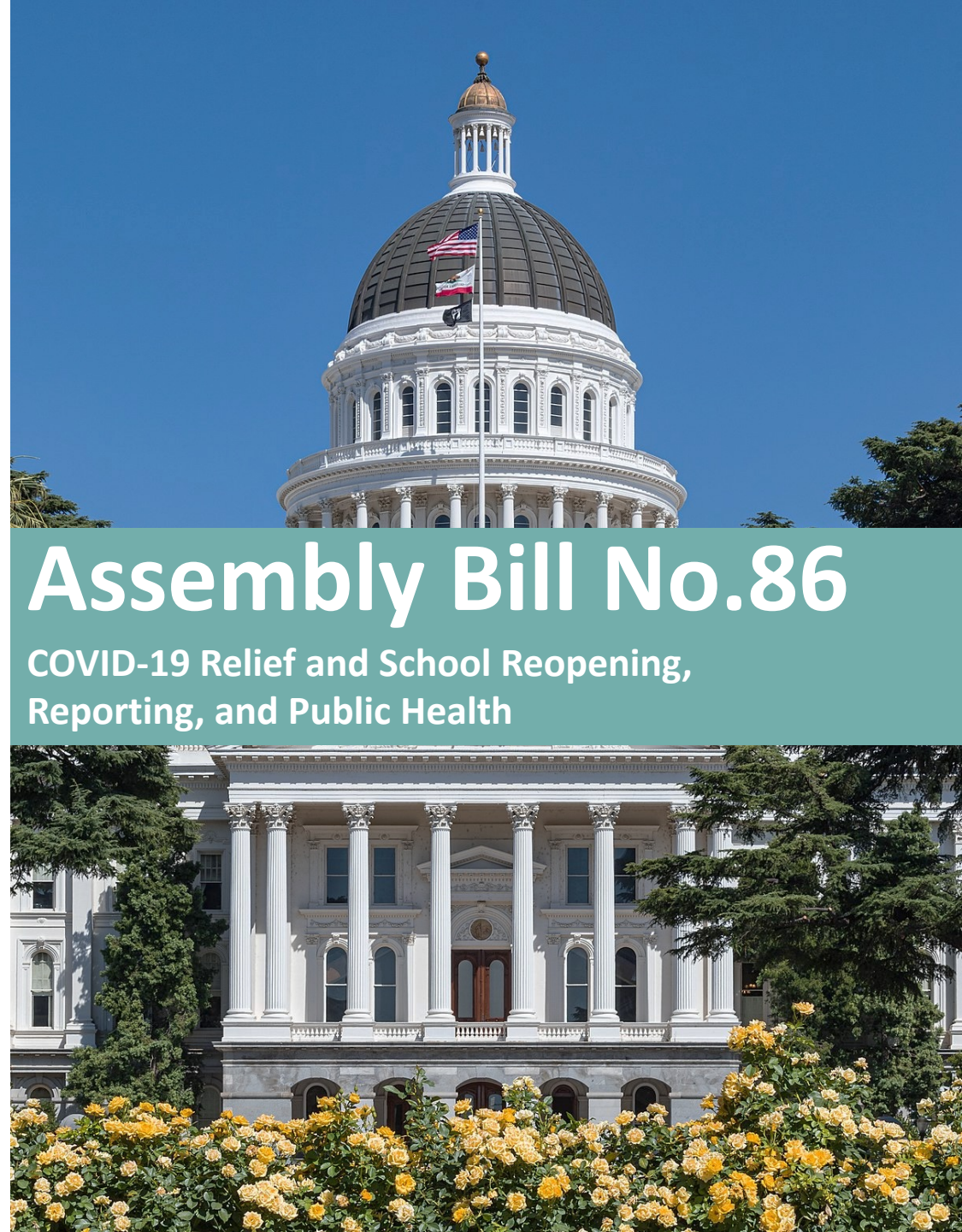
Shall only be expended for the following purposes

- Integrated pupil supports, such as the provision of mental health services and access to school meal programs
- Support for credit-deficient pupils to complete graduation or promotion requirements
- Additional academic services for pupils, such as diagnostic, progress monitoring, and benchmark assessments of pupil learning to close achievement gaps
- Training for school staff on strategies to engage pupils' social-emotional health needs and academic needs

In-Person Instructional Grants

May be used for purposes consistent with providing In-Person instruction, including but not limited to:

- Cleaning, disinfecting, and PPE
- Ventilation and other school upgrades for health and safety
- Salaries for certificated and classified employees providing In-Person Instruction or services
