Replacing the school's turf, track and tennis court resurfacing, and a new sound system for the field house.

- » Redesigning the senior high cafeteria into a flexible, comfortable, multi-use space for students and teachers;
- » Funding extensive safety and security improvements, parking lot repairs, and improvements to exterior lighting; and
- » Repairing the HVAC system to improve air quality using CARES Act federal funding.
