The AHERA (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act)

The AHERA (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986) regulations require that building occupants, and their legal guardians, are informed yearly of inspections, response actions, and post response action activities which are planned or in progress in the school buildings. PENNCREST School District is responsible for this notification.

It is the intention of the PENNCREST School District to comply with all federal and state regulations in regards to asbestos communications, monitoring, sampling, and abating via a management plan.
