<u>Crime & Safety Report for the Liberty Community – District 5</u>: Salt Lake City Police Departments, Detective Andrew Pedersen reports burglaries have increased 162% in the last 28 days. (21 compared to 8 during the same time last year). The burglary detectives have found fingerprints belonging to the same person at multiple scenes. We are now looking for an Adult male on a white mountain bike, approximately 6' tall wearing a black hoodie. This is very limited information, but at this time that is all they have. Any information that would help to track down the person(s) responsible would be appreciated. The challenge we have in solving many of these property crimes is due to the lack of follow up information. I know that more and more people are equipping their properties with Ring doorbells or surveillance cameras, both great ideas to help us do our job better. In addition to the increase in burglaries, almost every other part of crime is down to include car prowls down 23.1%, robberies down 100% for business, 60% "all other", and vehicle thefts are down 82.5%. In all part one crimes are down 17.4%. Command staff and CIU are continually looking to find innovative ways to reduce crime in District 5 and throughout the city.
