BHS Registration Timeline

- **February 8th –12th** Counselors will visit English classes to present registration process and registration begins
- **February 8th – February 26th** –Review course selections with parent/guardian(s). Complete your online registration through StudentVUE (see directions below on how to enter your course selections online)
- **February 26th** – Online course requests must be completed by February 26th for 9th -11th grade students
- **March 8th – 12th & March 22nd – 24th** – Counselors will meet with students individually to review online course requests
Students need to sign up for a 1-on-1 zoom meeting with their counselor

Step 3: Start entering the Course ID for the classes you want to take. For Example, Course ID ENG200 will give you both the A and B option for English 10. Make sure you choose both since you are registering for a year-long class. Enter all 14 course requests by choosing (Add Request).

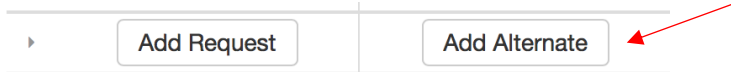

Step 4: Once all 14 requests are in, then add your Alternates by choosing the alternate button. *These are your back-up classes. Enter at least 4 of them.*



Step 5: When you are done entering your classes and alternates, double check your work by clicking on the on the “Return to Course Summary” button.



You will then be able to see your “Graduation Status Summary” where you can double-check your work. In this instance, the student has chosen English 10 and the graduation status has moved English 10 from the “Remaining” column to the “Credit for Requested Courses” column:
