### BHS Registration Timeline

- **February 8<sup>th</sup> –12<sup>th</sup>** Counselors will visit English classes to present registration process and registration begins
- **February 8<sup>th</sup> – February 26<sup>th</sup>** –Review course selections with parent/guardian(s). Complete your online registration through StudentVUE (see directions below on how to enter your course selections online)
- **February 26<sup>th</sup>** – Online course requests must be completed by February 26<sup>th</sup> for 9<sup>th</sup> -11<sup>th</sup> grade students
- **March 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> & March 22<sup>nd</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup>** – Counselors will meet with students individually to review online course requests  
Students need to sign up for a 1-on-1 zoom meeting with their counselor

For Example, Course ID ENG200 will give you both the A and B option for English 10. Make sure you choose both since you are registering for a year-long class. Enter all 14 course requests by choosing (Add Request).

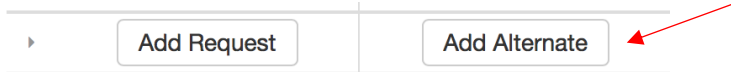
