Graduation Requirements:

- > 2021 graduates have 3 types of diploma options:
 - 24 credit diploma: shows "Davis School District" as issuer
 - o 27 credit diploma: shows "Davis Connect High School"
 - o 27 credit diploma from your boundary school, if you requested that
- All diploma types must still clear the same categories. For instance, they must still earn 4.0 credits in English, 3.0 Science, 1.5 Fine Arts, and so on.

Steps for Graduation Approval:

- 1. Pass your current classes.
- 2. Clear all U's through community service (3 hours per U) and paying a citizenship fee.
 - a. You can look for a negative balance under Citizenship on your Graduation Summary. If there's anything below 0, you have U's to make up.
 - b. Contact the Davis Connect citizenship secretary, Lani Porter, at <u>LaPorter@dsdmail.net</u> for more assistance.
 - c. If you are receiving the 24-credit diploma through Davis School District, Lani Porter can assist you with signing a Citizenship Contract to cover this.
- 3. Pay all class fees. Lani Porter can verify what fees are owed and verifies they've been paid.
- 4. Pass the Civics Test required by Utah Law. This will be done in your US Government class. If you are not taking US Government this year, contact your School Counselor to get the test loaded into myDSD for you to take.
- Return your Davis School District computer. Contact <u>DavisConnectTech@dsdmail.net</u> for information on where to take that. They will verify it's been returned.
- 6. Complete the Exit Survey: <u>https://forms.gle/zyEaSENENsLRnUaL9</u>
- 7. Complete all required credits for graduation.
 - a. Your assigned counselor will verify this once grades are posted for your current classes.
 - b. Counselor will also verify other steps have been completed.
